Welcome

Attendees introduced themselves around the table.

Review and Approval of Agenda

The committee accepted the agenda as presented.

Coke Battery Performance – Q3 2025

Katie provided a summary of the results of the daily and 30-day rolling average results for the Method 303 environmental audits. The coke battery is in compliance with the 30-day rolling average limits.

Tyler and Stephen stated that they had no comments.

Additional Updates

Stelco provided a summary of additional feedback received from neighbours in Q3 2025, and steps taken to address feedback.

Community Feedback

One member asked if there are certain coke ovens that leak more than others. Katie indicated that Operators track all ovens, but especially focus on ovens that may have more problems. Whenever required, ovens are taken out of service for maintenance or repairs.

One member asked about the status of the Quarry Landfill Expansion project environmental studies. Katie advised that the work remains in progress. Once completed, the information will be shared with interested public, including this CLC group.

One member asked about the status of the by-product electricity generation facility. Katie confirmed that it has been up and running for a few years now.

The group also discussed about air quality including a study by McMaster University, and about air quality monitoring within the area. Stephen noted that the MECP is looking to expand air quality monitoring networks, including Nanticoke.

The group also briefly discussed the tree planting project that Stelco undertook in recent years. Katie indicated that the original campaign was not as successful as hoped. Stelco will look at if there could be future opportunities.
