### Welcome

### Review and Approval of Agenda

The committee accepted them as presented. The committee also accepted the draft meeting notes of the July 16, 2025 previous meeting.

### Coke Battery Performance

Katie provided a summary of the performance of the Hamilton Works coke battery operations for Q3 2025 based on the Method 303 environmental audits conducted on a regular basis. Coke battery audit results demonstrated compliance with all 2025 limits; no operational adjustments were required for daily thresholds.

In response to attendee questions, the coking process was described and the Environmental Compliance Approval (ECA) requirements which necessitate this reporting. Stelco provided some background on how the thresholds were developed.

Stephen Burt from the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) commented on Stelco's continued compliance with MECP's objective. Stephen also shared that Kaela Buck will be taking over as the District Supervisor and the facility's Enforcement Officer will be Tim Crawford. When MECP opened the floor for questions, none were received.

### Community Comments

Committee members and observers inquired about providing the facility's abatement plan to the CLC and how Stelco communicates with the community about upsets (for example planned demolition). Stelco confirmed that notice is provided to the MECP and to CLC members as necessary regarding planned operational events that may impact our performance and be of concern to the community. Stelco also confirmed that it intends to continue this practice.
