Welcome

Attendees introduced themselves around the table.

Review and Approval of Agenda

The committee accepted the agenda as presented.

Coke Battery Performance – Q4 2025

Katie provided a summary of the Method 303 coke battery audits conducted in Q4 2025. The coke battery is in compliance with the 30-day rolling average limits established by the MECP.

Tyler stated that they had no major comments. Kaela indicated that the MECP is continuing to work on the industry standard.

Additional Updates

Stelco provided a summary of additional feedback received from neighbours in Q4 2025, and steps taken to resolve concerns that were raised.

Community Feedback

Members asked some questions related to recycling and flaring of by-products gases generated on-site such as coke oven gas and blast furnace gas. Stelco recycles these gases as much as possible for further use on-site such as for use in utility boilers and other operations like hot rolling reheat furnaces where steel slabs are converted to steel coils.

Katie also confirmed that the by-product electricity generation facility has been up and running for a few years now.

Studies related to the Quarry Landfill Expansion project continue; it remains a work in progress. Results will be shared with interested stakeholders as they become available.
